* In Belgium there are no professional fishing vessels in line with the Commission's SSF definition. The requirements to be part of a small-scale coastal fleet segment for a vessel under Belgian flag are:

- LOA under 24 m
- Engine power max 221 kW
- BT max 70
- Operate within 25 nm from the Belgian coast
- Not be at sea longer than 48 hours
- Confirm compliance with certain administrative conditions when applying for a Coastal License with the Belgian authorities.

The NWWAC member organization Rederscentrale, representing the Belgian sector, includes 10 vessels complying with the aforementioned conditions out of a total fleet of 65 active licenses.

** The CNPMEM represents all the fisheries sector in France and thus also the SSF fisheries interest.

*** VisNed is an umbrella organisation of 5 PO's with members fishing for flatfish and brown shrimps. They are in association with the organisation NetVISwerk, whose membership is entirely made up of small-scale fishermen, fishing with trawl, hook-line and static nets. The total number of vessels in VisNed membership is 260, while NetVISwek has 85 members.
