

#### Review of Rules of Procedure

NWWRAC General Assembly 26 September 2012

#### Background

- Decision of GA/AGM September 2011:
  Mandate to Secretariat to amend rules of procedure.
- Rules not revised since the creation of the NWWRAC (September 2005) – current practices.
- Reference document for researchers and consultants.

#### What has been done so far?

- Proposal submitted in February 2012 asking members for feedback and contributions.
- Comments received from 2 members: incorporation into suggested revised text.
- Draft proposal presented today for comments only. Final, approved version to be presented for adoption at the first Executive Committee 2013.

#### Overview: Basic ideas

- Align terms of office for all NWWRAC positions to three years.
- Update rules of procedure in line with current practices.
- Several "cosmetic" changes (terminology, article numbering, etc.) to improve consistency and coherence of the text.

## Main changes proposed: *Operating Principles*

- Inclusion of NWWRAC Vice-Chairs to assist the Chair in liaising with Member States, EU bodies and wider audience.
- Adoption of decisions by the Executive Committee either present at a meeting or by fast track electronic procedure (e-mail).
- Consultations for emergency measures (requisite 3 languages).

#### Main changes proposed Articles

- Art. 6: Increase deadline from 14 days to 2 months for uploading meeting reports.
- Art. 12: Remove "location rotation" of meetings.
- Art. 14: Role of the RAC WG Chairs at the ExCom.
- Art. 15: Work of Steering/Focus Groups.
- Arts. 17 and 46: Application for RAC membership.

### Main changes proposed Articles (cont.)

- Art. 21: Expand definition of observers.
- Arts. 24-25: Consistency regarding number of Executive Committee members.
- Art. 32: Formalise work with the European Parliament.
- Art. 35: Broaden category of experts at meetings to include economists and academics.

#### Way forward: timetable

- The proposed amendments will be circulated in the 3 working languages of the RAC (EN-FR-ES).
- Addressees: GA members, Member States and European Commission.
- A consultation period of 6-8 weeks will be open for submitting comments.
- The revised text will be put forward at the next Executive Committee meeting for adoption (January 2013).
