MareFrame seeks to remove barriers preventing a more widespread use of an Ecosystem-based Approach to Fisheries Management (EAFM). It includes stakeholders at its core using a co-creation approach that combines analytical and participatory processes to provide knowledge that can be applied to policy-making, improving management plans and implementation of EAFM. All the Advisory Councils (former RACs) have been invited to join the project as full partners. Due to several reasons -including administrative burdens and lack of resources- this option was not available for all of them. Therefore, what is the role of the ACs in MareFrame?
