Terms of Reference

- An agreed strategy for the management of brown crab fisheries in the NWWAC region, that recognises the existing different regimens in the producer countries and devises means to reach:
- 1. A coherent approach to optimise the use of management measures for brown crab.
- 2. Adoption of management plans (for example Fisheries Improvement Programs (FIPs)) by producer countries, as necessary and appropriate, to:
- (i) achieve certification at the highest possible level e.g. Marine Stewardship Council (MSC)
- (ii) achieve best possible self-management of brown crab fisheries without prescriptive, top-down regulatory measures.

- Previous meetings of Brown Crab FG Paris & Dublin 2017:
 - MS data not comparable
 - National management measurements are not comparable
 - Opportunity for FG to address this issue?

- September 2017:
 - -Isle of Man fisher-based data collection
 - Offer of financial support from Funding
 Fish for data collection project

- Draft proposal developed:
- Select one representative vessel in each f the Areas Orkney, Via, South West, Irish Sea, Celtic Sea and Channel.
- Install identical remote electronic equipment on each vessel
- Train the crew on operation
- Operate for 12 months to provide a "snapshot" of comparable non-randomised data
- Assess data to determine the value of remote electronic monitoring by fishermen for future management strategies

- Draft proposal contd.:
- The Brown Crab FG would act a Steering Committee
- The administrative costs would not be any greater than those already being generated by the operation of the FG (€30,000)
- The operational costs would be met by Funding Fish (€74,000)

- November 2017:
 - Draft Project submitted to EXCOM
 - Not approved

- Revised version:
- Proposal to demonstrate the value of concerted fisher-based data collection using remote electronic monitoring (REM) systems for brown crab (Cancer pagurus) in North Western Waters

Questions to be resolved

- Should NWWAC be involved directly in this or similar projects?
- If "YES" what are the supporting funding possibilities?
 - Bord Iascaigh Mhara Sustainable Fishing Scheme?
 - Transnational Fisheries Local Action Group (FLAG) (FARNET)?
