The Advice Drafting Group (ADG) will work in the following time frame: 2 November 2020 – 7 December 2020.

The ADG will work via virtual meetings and written electronic procedure. The final draft advice will be submitted to relevant Executive Committees for approval by November 25. Deadline for submission of the final advice to the Commission is 07 December.

NWWAC:

The ADG will function within the Horizontal Working Group. Papers produced by the ADG will undergo a written procedure at the NWWAC ExCom for revision and adoption.

LDAC:

The actions of the ADG will be channelled through the dedicated LDAC Focus Group on International Ocean Governance (IOG). The key outputs and written documents produced will be submitted for approval to the LDAC





Working Group 5 (Horizontal Issues) and the ExCom for comments and adoption by fast track procedure (minimum period of 8 calendar days).

MEDAC:

The ADG will function under Working Group 1 (Climate change). Outputs and papers produced will be considered by the mentioned Working Group and put forward to the MEDAC Executive Committee for comments and approval through urgent written procedure.

MAC:

The ADG will function under Working Group 1 (EU Production). Outputs and papers produced will be considered by the mentioned Working Group and put forward to the MAC Executive Committee for comments and approval through urgent written procedure.

NSAC:

The group is placed under the Executive Committee as a horizontal issue. Any advice will be submitted for a 10-day written procedure for approval by the members of the Executive Committee.

PELAC:

The ADG will function within the Ecosystem Focus Group. Papers produced by the ADG will undergo a written procedure at the PELAC ExCom for revision and adoption.

Objective:

The aim of this ADG is to provide feedback on the Roadmap of the European Commission's initiative "Maritime sector – a green post-COVID future". This initiative will identify ways to make the EU's blue economy more sustainable, in line with the European Green Deal. The goal is to aid economic recovery and tackle climate change, by promoting sustainable products and services – e.g. marine renewable energy – that preserve the marine environment and maintain ocean health.
