# 3. Questions for Inter-AC on 6 February afternoon session on the new Control Regulation

- Margin of tolerance applied to the total volume is it to be applied per catch or per species?
- 2. Question on ports outside of designated ports to be done on a species by species basis?
- 3. Weighing on board or in the port? Not clear whether workable exceptions to the weighing obligations on landing will remain possible.
- 4. CCTV introduction which vessels will have to get cameras on board and what will be the criteria for evaluating high risk? (to discuss with EFCA as well)
