# What are we talking about?



## Revised Fisheries Control Regulation

- On 9 January 2024, the new Regulation amending the EU fisheries control system, including the Control Regulation, entered into force.
- Most of the provisions will enter into force in 2026, 2027, 2028.
- Some important new changes concern: new mandatory control tools, weighing and catch registration rules, rules on digitization, new rules on margin of tolerance (MoT), greater control of the external fleet, harmonised rules on sanctioning, improved rules on traceability






# Implementation of the Fisheries Control Regulation

- The co-legislators have granted the Commission powers to adopt implementing rules under the Control Regulation.
  - Deadlines are set mean that key obligations will enter into force on a specific date [No flexibility].
- These specifications are **essential for operators and Member States** to comply with the new regulation.
- The current Control Implementing Regulation (Regulation 404/2011) would be repealed.
- The new Implementing Act and Delegated Act are urgently needed to ensure legal clarity and a smooth transition for Member States and stakeholders.

# **Current situation**

IA DA 2026 End of February: a consolidated draft will be communicated to MS to receive their feedback

June/July 2025: Planned adoption of IA and DA

January 2026: IA and DA enter into force

Technical meetings on all subjects

Working on consolidated draft

IA Weighing 2027

Mid 2025: a consolidated draft to be shared with MS

Planned adoption of IA on weighing

Before January 2027: IA on weighing enters into force

# New Implementing and Delegated Acts

2026 New IA and DA: Revision of existing provisions from the CIR 404

#### Elements to be covered:

- Frequency of transmission
- Electronic transmission of logbook
- Point system for masters of fishing vessels
- Digital catch reporting

#### 2027 New IA on weighing

New rules must be finalised by January 2027, when current Sampling Plans expire



### 2028 Implementing and Delegated Acts

#### **New implementing rules:**

- REM
- Segments at risk
- Continuous engine power
- Small scale fishery
- Digitalisation of traceability for prepared and preserved FAPs and Algae



### Derogation to the Margin of Tolerance

- Several Member States have expressed interest in listing ports under the revised Control Regulation.
- Proposals need to be aligned with conditions set out in Articles 2 and 3 for EU ports and with Articles 4 and 5 for third-country ports of Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/1474.



# Example empowerment – Article 8 revised Control Regulation Vessel Monitoring Systems

- 1. Member States shall operate vessel monitoring systems for effective monitoring of position and movement of the fishing vessels flying their flag, wherever those vessels may be, as well as of fishing vessels in their waters. Each flag Member State shall collect and analyse the vessel position data and ensure its monitoring on a continuous and systematic basis [...]
- 5. When a Union fishing vessel is in the waters of another Member State, the flag Member State shall make available the vessel position data of that vessel by automatic transmission of the data received to the fisheries monitoring centre of the coastal Member State [...]
- 8. The Commission shall, by means of implementing acts, lay down detailed rules on: (a) the format and content of vessel position data; (b) the minimum requirements and minimum technical specifications of vessel monitoring devices; (c) the frequency of transmission of the data concerning the position and movement of fishing vessels, including in fishing restricted areas; (d) the transmission of data to coastal Member States; (e) the responsibilities of the masters of fishing vessels concerning the operation of vessel monitoring devices [...]
