The EFCA is considered as a "cruising speed"
 Agency

Hence, 6%* Budget cut

Only a modification of a legislative act with an agreed financial statement by the budgetary authority detailing the impact on posts could be regarded as a basis for being considered as a 'new tasks' agency."

* The activities proposed in 2013 are pitched at net 6% less than the Financial Programming

Considering the overarching objectives of sustainability, compliance and level playing field, the Member States and DG Mare expectations, the legal framework governing the EFCA activities and the resources available, the Agency will concentrate on the core tasks as follows in 2013 - 2017:

Proposed Priorities:

- 1.1. Operational coordination;
- 1.2. Capacity building;
- 1.3. Cooperation with Third Countries.



JDP's



Activities:

- Legal basis through SCIPS
- Regional risk analysis, each 6 months/annually
- Common implementation through campaigns
- Common assessment for each campaign and JDP
- Workshops for inspectors and IUU officials



How can we move forward?



- Main objective of EFCA multiannual WP
- Need the appropriate Legal Framework (SCIP), which foresees a regional JDP coordinated by EFCA
- Regional JDPs are a tool to foster cooperation which could be used in the wider context of the reform of the CFP (e.g. discards, traceability, penalty points)



State of Play



- Full reality in the Southern North Sea:
- Progressive implementation on pelagics WW JDP
- Limited implementation on the Northern North sea and Baltic Sea:
 - Campaigns covering only cod, progressively longer campaigns have been introduced
- Concepts applied in BFT Med JDP, but single species
- Full reality NAFO/NEFAC



The Southern North Sea case




- Covers cod and associated species (sole and plaice)
- Year-round campaign, with permanent exchange of information and intelligence
- Full integration of national control activities under JDP, without extra burden to MS
- Key concepts: mutual assistance (core FPVs and associated FPVs), flexibility, consensus
- Costs saving and increased transparency recognised as a plus by MS
