MOTION from the delegations of the Mid Channel Potting Conference

on the joint management of Crustacean fishing effort in the Channel

The delegations of the Mid Channel Potting Conference met in Saint-Malo on the 25th and 26th of March 2013 and.

Emphasized the importance of the joint management of the Crustacean fishing effort in the Channel in order to sustain the resource and improve the market, by implementing adequate measures to the fleets concerned that would lead to the regulation of the overall fishing effort,

Wished that the ACRUNET programme should address the current situation in the fishing effort deployed by the different fleets in fishing brown crab and the efficiency of the existing regulations that limit this effort.

Wished the support of the European Commission and a strengthened collaboration of the governments concerned to support professional organizations in their efforts to regulate the **Crustacean fishing effort.**
