# Marine (Scotland) Act 2010 & Marine and Coastal Access Act 2009




- Duty to have a MPA network
- Power to designate MPAs
- Duties and powers to protect any MPAs
- Power to take account of socio-economics

# Marine Protected Areas Report to Parliament December 2012 The Sco



- 33 Nature Conservation MPA proposals
- 16 (+ 2 partials) in NWWRAC area
- 10 are in waters of UK exclusive access
- 6 are offshore

- 4 MPA search locations under consideration
- Acknowledged work still to do (SACs + SPAs)




## Complete the MPA network –
