- New 4-year approach proposed in 2021 for implementation in January 2022, start delayed until later in 2022
- Lump sum per AC based on current ceilings in place (NWWAC €330,000)
- Move from ex-post evaluation to ex-ante evaluation eliminating the annual assessment of actual expenditure and moving to balance payment based on deliverables achieved in the technical work programme (i.e., number of meetings, number of submissions)
- Continued payment of 80% of grant at start of financial year, balance payment following annual report
- Secretariats were required to submit draft budget proposals in January:
 NWWAC submitted four separate proposals covering financial years 18, 19, 20, 21
- NWWAC members were informed by email on 11 January

- Balance payment based on deliverables achieved -> change of work programme layout needed

TIMELINE:

- July 2022: GA approval of proposed budget and work programme for Year 18
- July/August 2022: submission of grant application to the Commission
- September 2022: COM approval of budget and work programme, signing of new
 Framework Agreement and Specific Agreement
- October 2022: COM payment of 80% grant (€264,000)
