

Commission Delegated Regulation 2022/204 amending Delegated Regulation 2015/242 (OJ L 34, 16/2/22)

laying down detailed rules on the functioning of the Advisory Councils under the Common Fisheries Policy

MARE D3 – Secretariats meeting of 25 February 2022

## Modifications introduced by the new regulation

- 1. Each AC shall designate at least one vice-chairperson from the category to which the chairperson does not belong.
- 2. The GA and the Ex-COM shall ensure a balanced and wide representation of all stakeholders, in particular of OIGs and SSF.
- **3**. Recommendations shall comply with CFP objectives, transparency, respect of all opinions, and be adopted via consensus. If non consensus, dissenting opinions shall be recorded.
- 4. External and independant performance reviews are to be conducted every 5 years.
- 5. Criteria for classifying members under the two categories of stakeholders (sector organisations and other interest groups) are added.



## Next steps

- Will enter into force on 8 March 2022
- Each AC will have to confirm with applicable rules and in particular, whenever needed:
- - nominate vice-chairs,
- - ensure a balanced representation of all stakeholders,
- - comply with rules on recommendations,
- - carry out performance reviews,
- - check that the members 'classification is aligned with the criteria set in the legislation, and correct the situation whenever needed.
