---

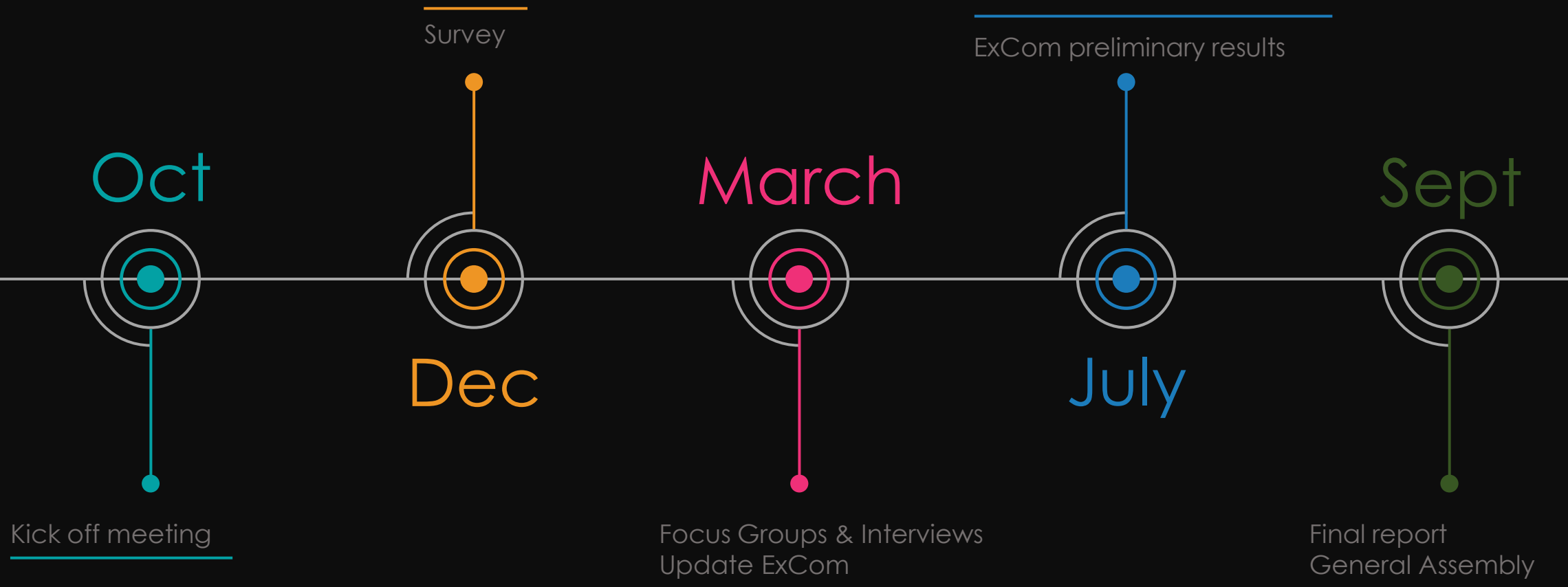
- Perform an external and objective assessment of the functioning of the internal bodies
