- Seafood Offshore Renewable Energy Working Group Established, within the context of the NMPF, by DHLG, DAFM and DECC.
- Initially a 2 year term from May 2022.
- Purpose Constructive engagement, promote best practice and safe operations, encourage liaison, publish a standard for communication for all foreseeable development types.
- > Recommendations on future arrangements and prioritisation of next issues.
- 6 Meetings to date, typically 40 people attend each meeting.
- Membership, 17 Seafood Sector Organisations; 4 ORE Developer Organisations; 3 Government Departments; 7 State Agencies.
