

# Joint NWWAC/PelAC Focus Group Spatial Dimension

- Joint NWWAC/PelAC advice on the impacts of underwater noise and offshore wind energy developments on commercial fisheries submitted on 11 October 2022
- Joint NWWAC/PelAC Briefing on the Maritime Area
   Planning Act 2021 Ireland held on 19 January 2023
- Draft Terms of Reference prepared by the Secretariats:
  - review previous advice submitted (as detailed above) in relation to potential impacts on commercial fish species from seismic activities, including underwater noise, and the development of ORE and follow up on identified issues where needed.
  - investigate the extent to which fisheries in the ACs remit areas are likely to be impacted by spatial squeeze due to the various developments taking place and planned for the future. This includes but is not limited to ORE developments and MPA designations.

- Pending: organisation of workshop with EFCA and NWW Member States on evaluation of compliance with the LO



### Terms of Reference – FG objectives:

All control, enforcement and compliance topics relevant to NWW fisheries. These include but are not limited to:

- The implementation of the existing and revised Control Regulation, considering where AC advice on control measures might be needed.
- Compliance with the landing obligation, especially considering the issue of article 27 of the technical measures regulation. Joint-AC work, especially with the Pelagic Advisory Council, might be considered where relevant.
- The impacts of the post-Brexit landscape on fisheries control. In particular, the FG will follow the work of the Inter-AC Brexit Forum1, both feeding on the information conveyed there and providing issues for discussion. This liaison will be done through the Secretariat and FG members who also participate in the Forum.
- Relevant actions and items raised in the Commission's package on the Common Fisheries Policy adopted on 21 February 2023.
