A 6-month period (March 2020 - September 2020) to

- 1) respond to the specific request from the Scheveningen Group (Deadline 01 May 2020), and
- 2) to address ongoing issues re. management of skates and rays (Deadline 31 August 2020)

Due to the outbreak of COVID-19 and related restrictions regarding travel, the group will commence its work via virtual meetings. The Secretariats will monitor the situation and organise a face to face meeting for all group members should this be required and once travel restrictions have been lifted.

#### **NWWAC**

The FG Skates & Rays will function within the Horizontal Working Group. The paper will undergo a written procedure at the NWWAC ExCom for revision and adoption. A final report to be presented at NWWAC September 2020 meeting in Dublin

#### **NSAC**

In absence of the NSAC Demersal Working Group chair, the Skates and Rays Focus Group will report directly to NSAC Executive Committee, with interim updates to Landing Obligation FG. The paper will undergo a written procedure at the NSAC ExCom for revision and adoption.
